

2017 ROCKY WINTER CARNIVAL TRAINER AND JOCKEY BONUSES

For the two-day Newmarket (June 22) and Rockhampton Cup (June 24) meetings in 2017, a new Mitsubishi Mirage 2016 model car valued at \$16,500 courtesy of Tropical Auto Group will be won by the trainer who earns the most number of points from placed (1st-2nd-3rd) runners over the two days.

The jockey who earns the most number of points from placed (1st-2nd-3rd) rides over these two days will win fuel for a year to the value of \$1200 (or \$100 a month) courtesy of Lowes Fuel Supplies and Smithy's Glenmore Road.

The points earned are based on the finishing position of the runners in each race held on the two days.

Race Points Allocation:

1st – 3 points; 2nd – 2 points; 3rd – 1 point.

Series Conditions:

In the event of a race being abandoned or declared a “no-race”, final acceptors remaining in the field, at the time of such abandonment or declaration of “no-race”, won't earn points.

In the event of a dead-heat in a race, the qualifying points will be combined and evenly divided between the dead-heated horses.

If at the end of the series there is a dead-heat in overall points, the winner will be the trainer/jockey with the most winners. A countback on most second placegetters, then third-placegetters will be conducted if required. If it is still a dead heat the prize will go to the trainer/jockey with the highest place strike rate.
