TRAINERS' MEMO: JUNE 2015

GRASS GALLOPS FOR FEATURE RACE STARTERS

Entrants in the four feature events of the \$100,000 Rockhampton Cup, \$100,000 Newmarket, \$50,000 QTIS 2yo Plate and \$50,000 3yo Plate are eligible for the special grass gallops on Saturday 13, Tuesday 16, and Thursday 18 June. The gallops will be between 6am and 7.30am on the outside of the main grass, subject to weather and track conditions.

JUMPOUTS AND GALLOPS SCHEDULE JULY AND AUGUST

With the conclusion of the winter racing carnival and the return of regular Thursday racing, the following schedule will apply in July and August. Note that there will be jump outs on the Tuesday following Rocky Cup day. Nominations close the business day before at 12 noon.

CLOSE OF GRASS TRACK FOR RENOVATION 21 AUGUST TO 25 SEPTEMBER

The RJC has applied to RQ to transfer the meeting of 10 September to Yeppoon racecourse as a RJC meeting to enable a complete renovation of the grass and recovery time prior to the race meeting on 25 September.

During this time the Yeppoon Turf Club will also hold their TAB meeting on Saturday 29 August.

Confirmation of the barrier trials and jump outs during this time will be advertised once the meeting transfer has been agreed upon by RQ.

TWO BREEDER'S PLATES IN 2015 - SPLIT BY SEX - 6 NOVEMBER

The first two year old races of the 2015/16 season will be held on Friday 6 November with the inaugural running of the split sex races for the Breeder's Plate. The order of entry to the races is based on trial performance with two sets planned for Callaghan Park on Friday 9 and 23 October.

The Mackay Classic for two year olds will be held sixteen days later on Sunday 22 November.

RACE PROGRAM FOR ROCKHAMPTON AND YEPPOON - JULY TO DECEMBER

Attached is a summary of the race program for the Rockhampton and Yeppoon Clubs as a guide. The final details are as per the RQ website and magazine.

\$10,000 TRAINERS' BONUSES TO BE WON OVER TWO FEATURE DAYS

For the two-day Newmarket (June 18) and Rockhampton Cup (June 20) meetings in 2015, there will be \$10,000 in bonuses for the trainers earning the most number of points from starters over the two days. The \$10,000 is split 70% for the highest, 20% for second highest and 10% for third highest points earned.

The points earned are based on the finishing position of the runners in each race held on the two days. Race Points Allocation: 1st - 10 points; 2nd - 8 points; 3rd - 7 points; 4th - 6 points; 5th - 5 points; 6th - 4 points; 7th - 3 points; 8th - 2 points and other runners - 1 point.

Series Conditions: In the event of a race being abandoned or declared a "no-race", final acceptors remaining in the field for such heat, at the time of such abandonment or declaration of "no-race", shall be allocated one (1) point. In the event of a dead-heat in a race, the qualifying points will be combined and evenly divided between the dead-heated horses. If at the end of the series there is a dead-heat in overall points, the winner will be the trainer with the most wins, then seconds and thirds. If it is still a dead heat the bonus will be shared.
